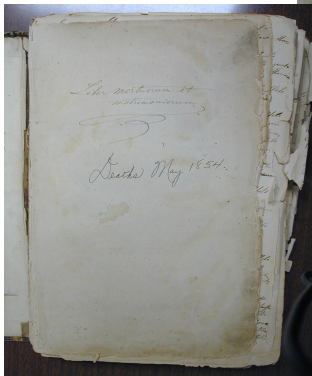
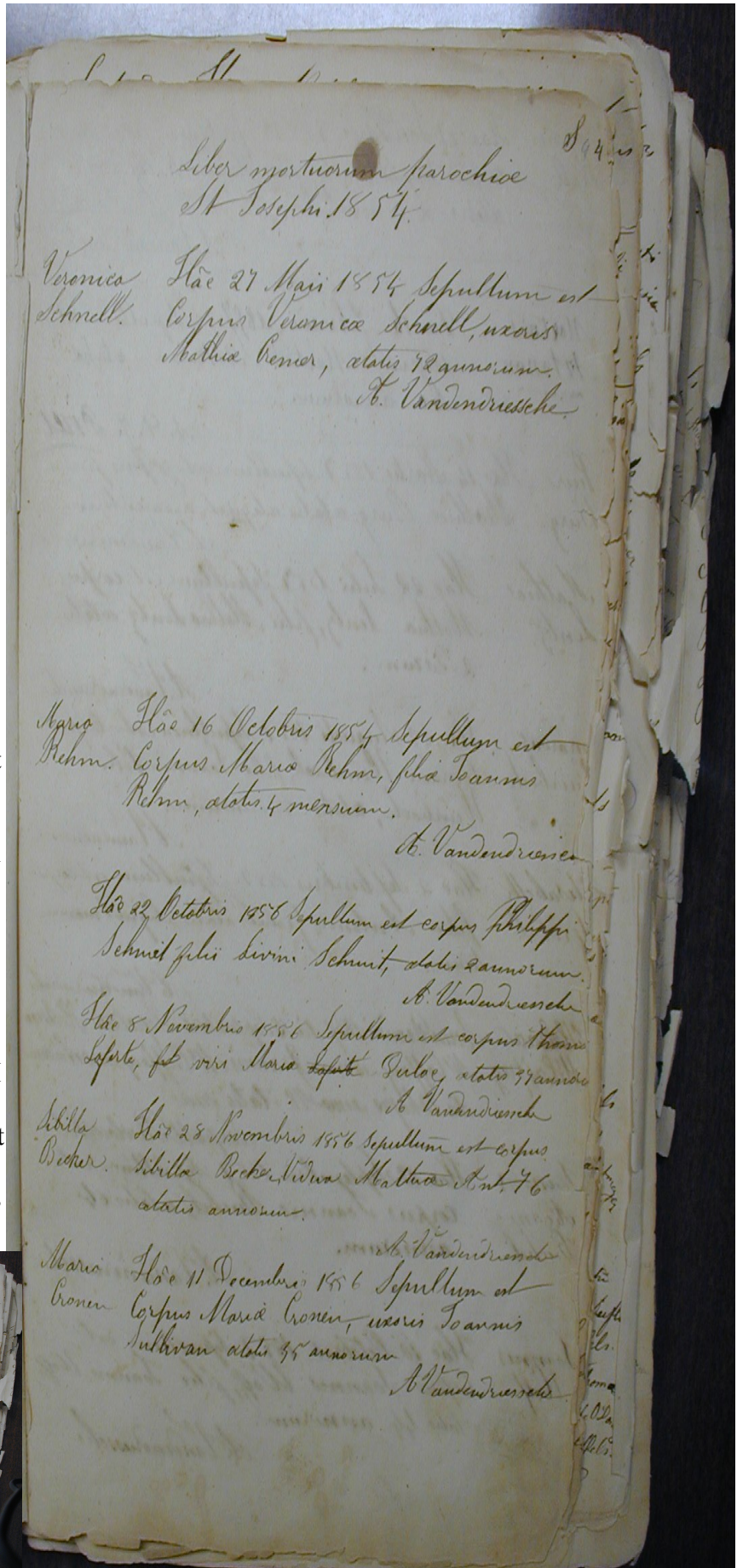


Oldest records of St Clement  
Cemetery

To the right is the oldest record of burials in St Clement. There are more of the old records printed on the following pages. If you wish to examine your family record you may click on the link to see and magnify the actual image itself. These images are also on Wesley Arnold's historical CD which is free. These are the actual records from St Clement church which were thrown on the floor with other trash when I discovered this book and gave it to the church office for safekeeping. Years later I took these pictures with permission of the church pastor and gave CD's of them to the church to use to search, examine and print records because the old book pages were crumbling due to deterioration. I left the book in their possession. With each new priest it appears that old caretakers are fired and new ones replace them but often in this process there is a lack of care given to protect the historical records. Now I have been told several times that they now do not know what happened to the old books. I am proud of the community of St Clement and even though I was never an official Catholic member I am proud and happy to have been instrumental in the saving of at least images of their records. What they have done with their own records is unknown,
