TATRO FRANCIS Born about 1843 (MI). Enlisted in company H 2nd MI Cavalry, Sept 3, 1861 at Warren for 3 years age 18. Mustered Oct 2, 1861. Transferred to Veteran Reserve Corps April 10, 1864. Widow Loretta filed request 12/3/1883. According to pensioners roll of 1883 he was wounded in left hand as a result of the war. D Oct 19,1883. A memorial with his name on it and 29 other soldiers was stolen by the Warren Hysterical grave robbing gang in 2011 without just cause. They have stolen at least five memorials including a memorial to all veterans and those who died in attacks on our country. (Such as Pearl Harbor and 9-11) More memorials are now missing. They do not own the memorials or the cemetery. This was done in secret without a vote of the membership or a public hearing. Nothing was found wrong with these memorials at a public meeting afterwards. This shows disrespect to our soldiers and those who died including 400 policemen and firemen. It appears that he was well liked by all. As neighbors one street over I had had many dealings with him and the result was always positive. He was asked many years later and long after he had retired from being a mayor to write a reflection about the times. This is what he wrote. "It was my philosophy to continue and improve upon the somewhat unique services rendered by the Community. It was there, with those intentions, that many of the services were maintained and expanded upon during my years in office. These services obviously were desired by the community at large, and the citizenry was willing to tax itself to provide for such things as sidewalk clearing and snow removal, twice per week rubbish collection, ambulance service, and numerous recreation and library functions, amongst other things. ...I have decided to talk about my feelings toward the Community and its people. My mother's family, the Buechels, were residents of the locale even prior to Center line's becoming a Village, and therefore, my sense of belonging, in relationship to the people of the Community, was and is extremely deep-rooted. There always seemed to be a certain uniqueness about Center Line, and although difficult to put into words, it involves the size of the Community, its geographical location, and more particularly, the attitude and spirit of the residents of the City. It has been apparent to me, from past to present, that there is a colloquial pride and sense of belonging: pride in one's family, one's church, one's school, and pride of home ownership. I can, with warm recollection, recall, at public gatherings, church activities, 4th of July celebrations, or whatever, people taking the time to talk to each other, to know and to care about each other. There is a reunion atmosphere, for example, when the Lions Club holds its annual breakfast. As the pace of the world seems to quicken, and the events of the day preoccupy and usurp our time, the opportunities to gather and communicate and relate to each other are indeed precious and unique. As there still exists that certain friendly, rural attitude. A part of these qualities, and the help of my fellow Council members, that allowed me to create an atmosphere in which our Community could persevere and overcome the problems that evolved during the years I held office. I can recall our former Congressman Nedzi making that same observation when reflecting upon the success of our Urban Renewal Program. It is with these warm and wonderful memories that I wish the Community the very best in its future, and for the well-being of all its citizens. With warm regards Peter J Tranchida Former Mayor"

Turmel. Tom an outstanding Master Gardener who has labored at Warren Union Cemetery every year since about 1997 as a volunteer. He took weed covered grounds with very few trees and planted grass, added colorful trees, shrubs and flowers. Volunteer Tom Turmel is responsible for hundreds of beautiful plants, shrubs and trees at Warren Union Cemetery. He has transformed a weed infested eyesore into a place of beauty and respect. Tom Turmel of Warren has donated and installed as of 2024 over 100 trees and shrubs. Many of these came from historic houses about to be demolished. For Example, the 9 Burning Bush shrubs were from the Homer Harwood estate. Before this time most of the cemetery was only grass with only the few big trees and the new Oak and Crab apple tree. One can see that he has transformed the cemetery into a place of beauty. He has done all of this without pay. Fourteen years later a stone plaque was presented to him and was going to be placed in the flower garden at Warren Union Cemetery but had to be given directly to Tom which he had placed in his home garden so the vigilantes would be stealing that also.

Tom has been saving plants and parts of historic homes about to be demolished for many years. He revives the plants and replants them at Warren Union Cemetery and Haney's Restaurant and many other places.

He also pointed out to me in a recent conversation how Pat Halman worked long and hard and saved the Bunert School from being demolished then at the dedication Sue Keffer and Becky Hetchler took the credit. Well that sounds familiar because they are the ones who asked two vigilantes to remove multiple memorial stones from Warren Union Cemetery probably because they could not take credit for them. They even admitted that to Officer Lt. Beck who was investigating the theft of the Memorial gravestones from Warren Union Cemetery. But they got off the hook because they claimed it was only a dispute on placement of stones, a lie and stated they knew where the stones were so the police treated it as a dispute among history people rather than a theft which it really was. As of 2024 they may have been responsible for the removal of nearly 20 gravestones even someone's epitaph. Those stones may have been trashed because they have not turned up anywhere to the best of our knowledge. They ripped the memorial to our Unknown Soldier off his grave. Removed a memorial that listed the Warren soldiers who are buried there. Removed a memorial to our pioneers and those without markers (which probably outnumber the burials with markers.) and they removed other memorials families had placed there. Some of us believe they did this because they could not get credit for placing those stones. Some were little bricks a historical researcher had placed on graves informing visitors of who was buried there because there was no longer a marker there, This was all done without vote of the Historical Commission or Historical Society, or City, or Village Historic Commission or the two Churches which were owners. This called vigilante action because they did not act with any approved authority and had their two husbands do this grave robbing crime. But they had the power to call it a historical dispute and got away with it. We veterans want to correct that.

Tom recently told me of how the City of Warren sent in the blight buster team who caused much damage by chain sawing anything they just felt like without consideration of the aesthetics or especially of the health of the plants. They cut into historic trees and shrubs leaving them exposed to diseases and attacks. He spoke to the city council, and they ordered money out of the Dorothy Cumings fund to repair nearly \$2,000 in damages done by the blight team mis-actions.

For nearly 30 years Tom Turmel has cared for Warren Union Cemetery and donated hundreds of plants, fertilizer and other supplies plus buying watering hoses. He pointed out that the city mowers recently carelessly ran over and shredded his hoses which he bought with his own money. I was also informed by others that the city now wants this volunteer to pay that he be bonded to be allowed to work in the cemetery. This has now put an end to his volunteer gardening. What a shame and what a loss.

Tom and another person made a historical record of the interior of Busch School just before it was torn

down. He has taken many pictures over the years including the interior of Busch school and the Pewabic tiles there. [Mary Chase Perry Stratton, a Detroit native and ceramic artist, is credited with creating the Pewabic ceramic tile technique in 1903. The term "Pewabic" comes from the Chippewa Indian word wabic, which means "metal," or bewabic, which means "iron or steel".]

Tom has been involved in many historical projects and causes. He is a great historian and has many unpublished historic pictures. I am proud of him and his many good works.

Perhaps his greatest achievements are the preservation and beautification of Warren Union Cemetery over almost 30 years and his help in historical preservation. Just look at Haney's Restaurant over many years to see the splendid work of this master gardener. Plus he is a great guy to know.
